Students will then be placed into small groups and will be involved in a mini school timetable. This will allow all students to experience a day in the life of a high school student and meet teachers from a range of faculty areas.

At 12:20pm, students are invited to a sausage sizzle, where they will have the opportunity to meet other students in their year and existing Gold Creek School students. The canteen will also be available for students to purchase food and drinks. Students can bring money on the day for the canteen if they wish.
