Picture Products - Preschool Only (order and payment extended)

The Picture Products activity has kicked off. Preschool parents can collect the drawing paper from Mr Will Powell.

Just make sure you take the right paper for the item you wish to produce, or you can print additional templates at home [HERE](#). Drawings are to be done at home.

Imagine your child's drawing printed on a 25cm melamine plate that is dishwasher safe and tough enough to use every day, or on a clock that is displayed proudly in the house.

Items that can be ordered include plates, clocks, water bottles, tote bags, mugs, pencil cases and calendars, and prices range from \$15 to \$30. These items also make wonderful presents for family and friends. A full list of items can be found [HERE](#).

The deadline to order and pay for the items has been extended until Friday 12 May. Drawings must be returned by Monday 15 May.

Orders and payments are all online and can be made [HERE](#). You will need to bring the artwork back to the Preschool for collection. Please give these to Mr Will Powell.

We anticipate the items will be ready around July. As each is individually made, it is a detailed and time-consuming process. The final product is worth it as you'll have a memory to last a lifetime.

- Ceramic Mug:** Make mum and dad's favourite time of day even better with their very own personalised Ceramic Mug, while the Plastic Mug is the perfect partner for picnics in the backyard or beyond.
- Pictureclock:** It's always time to smile with the 25cm melamine Pictureclock or the 20cm MDF Small Clock.
- Calendar:** Your picture above 12 tear-off month pages helps this Calendar keep the family organised.
- Tote Bag:** A fabric Tote Bag perfect for library books, sleepovers, gym clothes or shopping trips.
- Water Bottle:** Keep hydrated through the day with 600ml Water Bottle (shown) or backpack-friendly 400ml size.

Here's how to get the best result for your child's beautiful artwork.

- Use strong, bright marker pens, paints, craft dyes and good quality photos. You don't have to use special pens, just make sure the colours are bright and bold.
- Don't use pencils, crayons, metallics, fluoros or glitter. These don't show up very well on the finished product.
- Draw inside the drawing area marked on the template. We do our best, but up to 2cm can get trimmed off from one or more edges during manufacture, so make sure to keep important names and dates away from the edge.
- Write your child's name in the box in the top right corner and write the number of copies you'd like in the box below. Some drawing paper templates are used for more than one product, so make sure you are filling out the right box.
- Photos should be glued in place well. Large, bright close-ups are best as they will slightly blur and darken during manufacture.
- Some products may have features like clock hands or calendar hangars inside the drawing area. Be aware of these when placing your photos—nobody wants a clock mechanism between the eyes!

- Any marks in the drawing area may show up on the final product. Rub out any pencil marks properly or use a fresh sheet of drawing paper.
- Don't roll, fold or crease the paper. Keep it flat and free from damage.

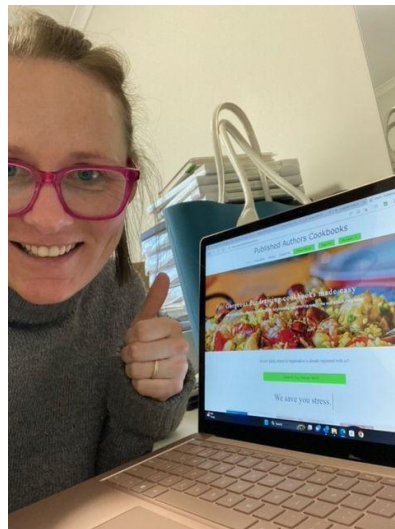
Ngunnawal Community Cookbook – Have you submitted your recipe yet?
