Kindergarten - Term 1 Weeks 5 and 6

PBL

In PBL, through class discussions and small group activities we are continuing to learn about our 'All Settings Expectations' and how to be safe, respectful and a responsible learner.

Reading

In Reader's Workshop, we will continue to learn about the different parts of a book through a book orientation to help us understand what we are reading. Students will demonstrate how to hold a book correctly and identify the front cover, title, author, spine and back cover.

Everyday students will have the opportunity to bring home a reading log with one quality text and one levelled reader. We encourage you to read each night with your child and record one reading entry per night in their log. At the front of their reading log you will find a login for their Decodable Reader's Australia account to support your child in developing their reading skills.

Writing

In writing, we will be learning how to correctly form the letters in our names and draw a picture linked with the books we are reading during our literacy experiences.

One Word Spelling

We are learning to recoginse and read different sight words. The focus words for this fortnight are:

am, at, in, is

Spelling

In spelling, we will be learning about letter sound relationships. This will include recognising both upper and lower case letters in our name, identifying the most common sounds and forming the letters of our name correctly. The focus letters and sounds this fortnight are:

M, D, G, O, C, K

Mathematics

Maths Number

In number, we will be learning about the numbers 2 and 3. We will be focusing on number formation and representing numbers in a variety of ways, such as tally marks, ten frames and pictures.

Maths Strand

We will continue learning to describe the location of an object using positional language. We will be exploring the positions of over, under, behind, on top, next to, and in front.

SEL

We are continuing to learn about the 'Zones of Regulation', the different emotions and how to identify which zone we are in. We will also be learning about how being in the yellow and red zone can affect our interactions with others. The four zones are blue, green, yellow and red.

We will be exploring these themes through class discussions and small activities.

Dance

In dance, students will be learning about dance safety, body movements and timing through class discussions and dancing activities.
