Kindergarten - Term 1 Weeks 9 and 10

PBL

In PBL, we are continuing to learn about being **safe**, **respectful** and **responsible** learners in all settings. We will have a focus on being safe at the oval and following teacher's instructions in preparation for term two.

Reading

In Reader's Workshop, students will be learning to read the beginning, middle, and ending sounds of words. To support your child at home you are encouraged to use Decodable Reader's to assist them to Australia resource consolidate their understandina their sounds so they can slide through the will find Ioain their Decodable Reader's Australia account on the inside of their reading log.

Please remember to send your child's reader bag in everyday so they can change their take home reading books.

Writing

We will be learning to identify the letters in our name and how to correctly form each letter. We will continue to draw pictures linked with the books we are reading during our literacy experiences.

One Word Spelling

We are learning to recognise and read different sight words. The focus words for this fortnight are: **by, to, me, he**

Spelling

In spelling, we will be learning the letters **B**, **H**, **F**, **L**, **J** and **V**

We will be practising recognising these letters in texts, making the sounds, forming the letters and finding words that begin with these letters. We will begin to sound out and write two and three letter words using our learned letters and sounds. For example: it, is, pen, sat, mat, dog.

Mathematics

Maths Number

Students will be learning about the numbers 7 and 8. We will be focusing on number formation and representing numbers in different ways, such as tally marks, ten frames and pictures.

Maths Strand

We will consolidate our learning of location and positional language. We will be reviewing the positions of on top, under, bottom, between, inside, next to, above, in front, left and right. In week 10, students will be assessed on their understanding of location and positional language.

SEL

We will be learning that different events in the day affect what emotions people experience and which zones we feel throughout the day. We will be exploring these themes through class discussions and small activities.

Science

We are learning about living and nonliving things. We will use our knowledge of external features to group animals with similar features for example two legs, wings.

Dance

Students will be learning to use different body movements to create a dance sequence.
