Yerrabi is partnering with Early Learning Connection to support deadly women interested in a career in early childhood education and care

Why should I apply?

We invite First Nations women to join a free work and study program:

- Get paid to work part-time at an early learning centre in the ACT
- Attend a supportive, culturally safe class in-person at Yarramundi Cultural Centre
- All course fees will be covered
- Be supported by your own coach, CIT teachers and other deadly women
- Help in creating more support for First Nations women interested in early childhood education

How do I join?

Expressions of interest welcome from women who:

- are of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent
- identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander
- are accepted by community as being Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander

Yerrabi is working with community, CIT and Early Learning Connection to support a class of First Nations educators in 2025.

Can you tell me more?

Led by the community, this program will offer guidance, support, and opportunities to develop skills and make connections. This will include:

- Employment support: opportunities to get paid to work and study part-time
- Family support: our team can help with enrolling your children at the same centre where you will be working and completing your placement
- **Cultural Safety:** we will partner with culturally safe early learning centres and will work with their staff to ensure they give students the best experience.
- **Playgroup available:** educators can care for your children at the same centre where you will be working and completing your placement.
- Technology resources: laptop loans available to support with your studies if needed
- **Coaching sessions**: personalised coaching for career growth, with community members and Yerrabi staff to support you every step of the way.
- Transport support: transport assistance to ensure you can attend classes

We are excited to support you! We love early childhood education and are happy you are thinking about joining this program to help you on your journey.

What will we be studying?	Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care Semester 1 2025 Unit: Care Practices
How much study is required?	One class per week, with end of term study sessions for extra support
When is class?	Thursdays, 9:30am - 2:30pm Term 1: 9 weeks - February to April (School holiday break) Term 2: 9 weeks - April to June
Where will classes be?	Yarramundi Cultural Centre 245 Lady Denman Drive, ACT 2601
Is morning tea provided?	Yes!
Will there be any work placement?	Yes - this can be completed at the centre where you work, so you can get paid to complete your placement hours
How many coaching sessions do I get?	At least 2 per semester, or as often as needed
