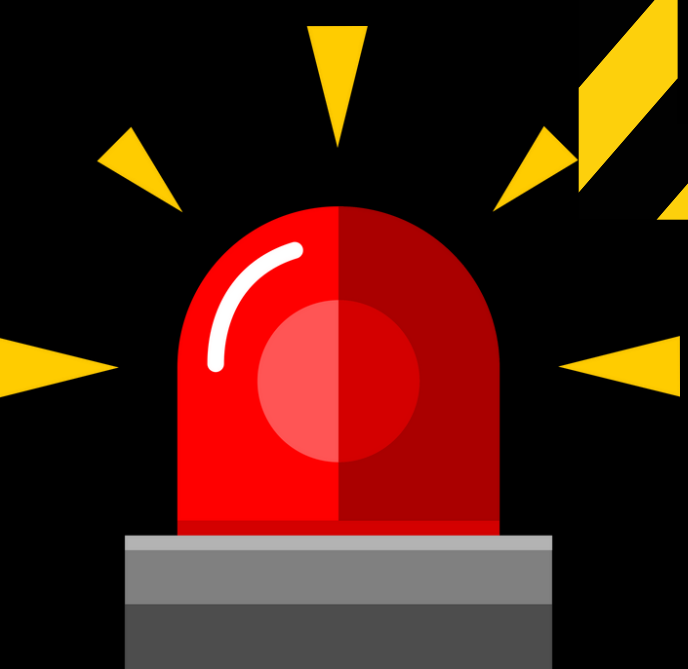

up to 5 books

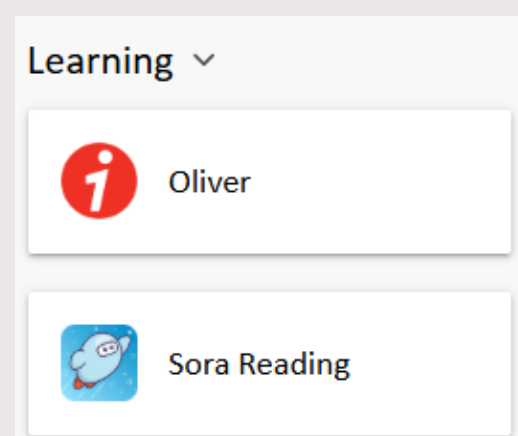
READING WHILE THE LIBRARY IS CLOSED
