



FREE FLU VACCINES FOR ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PEOPLE SIX MONTHS AND OLDER

The flu vaccine is safe and will help protect you and your loved ones from influenza this winter. The flu vaccine won't protect you against COVID-19 but it will help you avoid getting both viruses at the same time.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people experience significantly worse symptoms from influenza infections and are much more likely to be hospitalised.

The flu vaccine is available from Winnunga Nimmityjah Aboriginal Health Service, General Practitioners, ACT Health Early Childhood Immunisation Clinics or your usual immunisation providers.

Some immunisation providers may charge a consultation fee for administering the vaccine. You should check this at the time of booking.
